All the candidates who have submitted the Willingness Certificate for the typing test and whose names were notified vide this office notice of even number dated 23.05.2017 are hereby informed of the following :-

1. The typing test for the post of Assistant Grade III(Gen/F&A/S&P) will be held on **09th September 2017 (Saturday)**. **The typing test will be for a duration of ten minutes (Visually Handicapped candidates,if any, will be allowed 30 minutes.)**
2. The e-admit cards will be uploaded on the official website of CRRI www.crridom.gov.in on and after 21st August 2017. The e-admit cards containing the details of the venue,batch/shift and the timings and other related instructions reg typing test may be carefully read by the candidates.The e-admit cards will have to be downloaded by the candidate and shall have to be brought by the candidate on the date of the typing test without which he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the typing test. Further the instructions mentioned in the e-admit card regarding valid ID proof and other related instructions may be carefully noted by the candidates.
3. **The Scheme of Examination and the Syllabus** for the subsequent written test may also be seen carefully by the candidates at Annexure -A.
4. Further the CRRI website may be checked by the candidates from time to time for the latest updates on the issue.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION FOR WRITTEN TEST TO BE HELD LATER ON IN RESPECT OF THOSE WHO QUALIFY THE TYPING TEST

Time Allowed : Two & Half hours(2 & 1/2 hrs)* Total Marks : 150 marks

There will be a single paper which will be for a duration of two and half hours for a maximum marks of 150 . There will be no negative marking . The paper will consist of two parts --part A and part B . Details of the scheme of exam and syllabus are given as under :

***THREE HOURS FOR VISUALLY HANDICAPPED CANDIDATES**

PART 'A' : GENERAL KNOWLEDGE :

Test Type : Multiple Choice Questions(MCQ)

Total Marks : 90 marks

This part will have 90 Bilingual Multiple Choice Questions of One Mark each. Each question will have Four Options. A candidate is required to identify the correct answer.

SYLLABUS : The questions will be designed to test the ability /knowledge of the candidate's general awareness of the Environment, Current Affairs, and of such matters of everyday observation and will also include questions pertaining to History, Geography, General Science, Constitution of India, Art & Culture of India , Sports, Computer Knowledge, Logical Reasoning & Quantitative Aptitude etc. The questions would be such which do not require special study of any discipline as the same would be of general knowledge nature .

PART 'B' LANGUAGE : HINDI/ENGLISH :

Test Type : Multiple Choice Questions(MCQ)

Total Marks : 60 marks

This part will have 60 Multiple Choice Questions in Hindi and English each. A candidate is required to answer either Hindi or English questions as per the option by him/her.

SYLLABUS : The knowledge of the candidate of English language will be tested with regard to his /her knowledge of Synonyms, Antonyms, Homonyms, Spellings, Common Errors, Idioms & Phrases, One word substitution, Fill in the blanks etc.
