Steps for Raising Grievance Against the Answer Key

1. Click on the provided link for the Answer Key Challenge. You will be redirected to the homepage of the key challenge portal.
2. Enter your Registration Number/Roll Number and Date of Birth (DOB) to log in.
3. After entering the details, an OTP will be sent to your registered email ID.
4. Enter the OTP to proceed.
5. Upon successful login, you will be able to view your response sheet. You can check your answers and responses submitted during the exam.
6. On the top-left corner of the homepage, click on the "Grievance About Question" button. You will be redirected to the grievance submission page.
 - Enter the question number for which you want to raise a grievance.
 - You may raise multiple grievances for different questions by repeating the process.
7. After entering all your grievances:
 - Accept the Terms and Conditions.
 - Proceed to make the required payment.

Note: Once grievances are submitted, you will not be able to raise any further grievances.
